WHO ARE THE CHAMPIONS?

COMMON PEOPLE

Congregants and citizens who love the LORD and the liberties that He alone provides.

ADVOCATES

Committed to speaking two-kingdom principles into culture and church — religious liberty, sanctity of life, educational freedom.

CONNECTORS

Champions who build bridges into community organizations, local agencies, and state and federal government.

WHAT WE OFFER

THE CHAMPIONS *Academy.*

A one-, two-, or three-year set of educational resources for learning, discussing, praying, and engaging others in a humble but deliberate way. Each group in the Network is a **Champions Chapter**.

Resources are batched into session themes. Chapters meet at least monthly — many meet more often — adapting each session to their people.

TOOLKIT

Educational resources plus the communication apps that keep chapters in touch with Network staff — and with facilitators of other chapters.

CONNECTIONS

Chapter leaders talk with one another state to state, plus networking with state and federal legislators through our connections on The Hill.

FACILITATORS

Four to five chapter facilitators are enlisted with the Network Director and the congregation's pastor, so many hands make light work.

ACADEMY OUTCOMES

SEEKING TO BE USEFUL *in God's hands.*

- ◆ **Differentiate the two kingdoms** — discerning how God may be at work in the left-hand kingdom.
- ◆ **Engage with humble restraint** — vocationally respectful, listening and praying first.
- ◆ **Be constitutionally astute** — equipped to take the politics off the issues.
- ◆ **Speak to life, marriage, and education** — the freedoms most at stake.
